

# Clinical Services in K-Block #2

## Frequently Asked Questions

---

**Are there birthing baths in K-Block?** Yes, there are seven birthing suites that have their own birthing baths on level 7.

---

**Will there be patient scales that are easier to use?** Yes, there are a set of inbuilt electronic floor scales to support accurate weighing of patients standing or in a bed or chair.

They are located levels 6 – 10.

---

**Is there any new diagnostic and interventional equipment?** Yes, K-Block's angiography and cardiac catheterisation procedural suites will have state-of-the-art imaging technology with the \$7.38 million equipment contract now awarded.

Artis Q zen biplane will be installed for use in Cardiology and the Artis Q biplane will be installed for Vascular surgery and Interventional Radiology.

A \$2.5 million BrainLab AIRO mobile CT scanner has also been purchased.

**How many operating theatres are there?** There are five new operating theatres in K-Block which form part of the 14 operating theatre precinct across level 4 of A-, C-, D and K-Block.

---

**Where are the pneumatic tubes located?** A pneumatic tube bay is located behind reception and adjacent the staff write up on all inpatient wards.

---

**Are there any dedicated services for young people?** K-Block will have the first dedicated ward for young people with an adolescents' ward on level 6.

The 16-bed adolescents' unit includes two safe rooms with their own internal and external recreational space for vulnerable young people.

---
