

K-Block Level 2 West and Level 3 West – K2W and K3W

K2W and K3W accommodates the Mental Health Inpatient Unit.



Adult mental health services provide assessment, treatment, support and education to people aged between 18 and 65 years with severe and complex mental health problems.

The unit provides a safe, recovery focused, therapeutic environment for people during acute mental health episodes needing 24/7 observation, medication management, counselling and other support.

Mental health inpatients can generally move around, so it is important they have access to a range of recreational spaces and activities. Both wards include indoor and outdoor recreational areas.

K2W

K2W has:

- 17 beds and all patient rooms have an ensuite with one room designed to disability design standards
- recreation/dining and lounge areas
- activity and multi-use or family rooms
- outdoor/indoor terrace
- interview and meeting rooms.

K3W

K3W includes a high dependency unit and has:

- 16 single bedrooms including:
 - six high dependency unit beds with one room incorporating a lounge area and disability-designed ensuite for vulnerable people
 - nine secure single bedrooms including one with a disability-designed ensuite
 - one flex bed with ensuite.
- seclusion room
- de-escalation room
- courtyard area
- combined recreation/dining and lounge area
- laundry
- break-out space
- treatment room
- interview and meeting rooms
- staff offices
- lockers.
