

# K-Block Wayfinding #2

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Where is K-Block connected to the rest of the hospital?

K-Block connects to A-Block, C-Block, J-Block and D-Block.

### What floors have corridors to get into K-Block?

Lower Ground Floor has a corridor between K-Block and J-Block connecting the Emergency Department with major inpatient wards.

Ground Floor has public corridors between K-Block and A- and C-Blocks.

Ground Floor also has a back-of-house corridor between K-Block and D-Block.

Level 4 has corridors between K-Block and A-, C- and D-Blocks creating an operating theatres precinct.

### When will the corridors to K-Block open?


Linkways on Lower Ground Floor and Level 4 have been in place for some time and will be opened after K-Block works are finished.

Construction works to 'break through' on the Ground Floor of the existing buildings will be phased to reduce disruption to patients and staff.

Construction works to the main entrance of C-Block will create a corridor into K-Block.

This is scheduled after K-Block works are finished.

The back-of-house corridor on Ground Floor between D-Block and K-Block will be used as a temporary pathway while the C-Block main entrance works are finished.



## How do you get from Lower Ground K-Block into the rest of the hospital?

### Lower Ground




The K-Block and J-Block corridor on the Lower Ground Floor opens near EMU J (the doorway which is currently hoarded, Image 1).

This is a back-of-house corridor which will be used for patient transport between the helipad and the Emergency Department and the Emergency Department and K-Block wards.

This patient journey will take no longer than between three to five minutes.

# How do you get from Ground Floor of K-Block into the rest of the hospital?

## Ground Floor



Corridors connect the Ground Floor of K-Block to A-, C- and D-Blocks.

The corridor to A-Block is the first on the right (see floor plan above) when entering K-Block from Campbell Street.

It opens into A-Block opposite the Holman Clinic.

It is currently closed with hoarding (Image 2).

The corridor to C-Block is on the right of the K-Block reception.

The main entrance area of C-Block will be redeveloped to create a corridor into K-Block, provide more circulation space and will include a public art commission.

The corridor into C-Block will go through the decommissioned offices opposite the kiosk (Image 3).

These works are planned after K-Block works are finished.

A back-of-house corridor connects D-Block to K-Block from the front of the kitchen.

This will also be used to temporarily access K-Block while the C-Block main entrance construction works are completed (Image 4).

# How do you get from Level 4 of K-Block into the rest of the hospital?

## Level 4



K-Block connects to A-, C- and D-Blocks creating an operating theatres precinct.

There is hoarding covering a break-through on A-Block Level 4 opposite the rear entrance to Endoscopy and adjacent the rear entrance to Short Stay Surgery (SSS) (Image 5 from A-Block lifts and Image 6 from rear of SSS).

Some of the functions of SSS (C4) will move into K-Block and construction works in the current location will make a corridor between K- and C-Blocks.

This area is hoarded off in the SSS supplies store (Image 7).

Construction works from the C-Block corridor into the D-Block operating theatres will make a new corridor into K-Block.

The corridor will continue through the current Holding Bay which will be relocated into K-Block (note construction signage in Image 8 denotes area).
